Risk Management	<ul> <li>Our programs promote experiential, inquiry-based, play-based, and place-based learning and supports risk management where participants learn to work through challenges, experience risk, and learn from mistakes and successes which helps to build self-confidence</li> <li>Hand Tool Use (For Weekly/Monthly School Year/Adult Program Participants ONLY)         <ul> <li>Hand tools are locked away only accessible by educators</li> <li>Participants have opportunity to learn how to use and work with various hand tools under the supervision of a trained educator</li> <li>At the beginning of each term and throughout, educators will assess all participants' ability to use each hand tool safely, responsibly, and respectfully both independently and with other participants</li> </ul> </li> <li>Environmental Site Assessment         <ul> <li>Educators conduct daily site assessments independently and with the participants to ensure everyone's awareness of whether a space is safe to use (i.e. fallen trees, ice)</li> </ul> </li> </ul>

# **REGISTRATION PROCESS**

- Online Registration via Amilia; participants will need to create an account to register for programs
- All Registration will be accepted on a first come, first serve basis
- Registration is welcome on an on-going basis; fees will be pro-rated
- There is no guarantee additional sessions will have availability for registration received at a later date
- School Year Programs: Early registration will be available to participants who are currently registered; Participants may only register for a maximum of 2 days/programs per week



## REQUIRED FORMS - TO BE COMPLETED ANNUALLY & REVIEWED WITH EACH PURCHASE

- Participants must complete applicable child/adult Health & Medical Forms and review and sign (electronically) Health & Participant Waiver prior to their participation in the program; Digital signatures/text are considered binding agreements
- Participants will not be permitted on site without consent provided

## REFUND/CANCELLATION POLICY FOR ALL PROGRAMS

- When you choose to enroll in programs at Dogwood Forest, you are reserving space, time, supplies, and staffing. In many ways, the commitments we make to site preparation, program equipment, health and safety supplies, and staff are in place well in advance of programs beginning. The following policies have been created to address both the financial concerns participants may have and ensuring that the sustainability of operating and providing programs at Dogwood Forest can be maintained.
- All refund requests must be made in writing and supporting documentation may be required.
- Refunds due to medical or academic reasons will be considered on a per case basis:
  - Medical refund requests will be assessed at any point during the participant's program and must be accompanied by a doctor's note
  - An academic reason may be that participation in a program is not working out in the child's best interest and must be accompanied by a letter from the school administration and/or classroom teacher indicating that this is the case
- Cancellations initiated within 3 business days of purchase date and changes/transfer of fees in program groups or dates are charged 3% of the cost of the program to recover the associated administration fees

- Refunds will be issued in the original form of payment (i.e. refunded to your credit card or PAD).

# MISSED DAYS POLICY FOR ALL PROGRAMS

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Inclement Weather	<ul> <li>All program days will continue rain, shine, or snow</li> <li>No missed days due to inclement weather will be rescheduled or refunded</li> <li>For the Winter Term only, there will be one make up day tentatively scheduled for all participants the week following normal programming should Dogwood Forest feel it necessary to close for the day</li> <li>If school buses in Durham Region are cancelled due to inclement weather (eg. freezing rain/snow) on the day of our programs and we continue to run programs, it will be at your discretion whether your child attends the day.</li> <li>Participants should be prepared to be in all elements (Packing List access online)</li> <li>Safety is of utmost importance to us; no outdoor activities will take place during severe inclement weather, such as electrical storms or extreme winds or cold</li> <li>We will contact parents/guardians via email or text to pick up your child as soon as you are able and we will take shelter accordingly</li> </ul>

COMMUNICATION	<ul> <li>Email and Phone Calls are the main forms of communication with participants</li> <li>Dogwood Forest encourages and works to maintain positive and open lines of communication with participants; we do not have any direct contact with schools that participants attend</li> <li>We are open to receiving feedback about our programs and will address any questions or concerns in a timely and professional manner; we may not be able to meet all requests but we will remain open to finding a strategy or outcome that is more suitable for all those involved</li> <li>If a conflict or issue arises, we ask that all those involved are respectful and considerate of one another and understand that a reflection period may be required before returning to conversation; our goal is to create a positive and productive environment for sharing concerns and coming to a solution together.</li> </ul>
